having taken or subscribed the affirmation required by the said Act, and having
 affirmed that he together with Walter Smith and
 George A. French Merchants, and Ebenezer Jenkins Merchant
 of the state of New-York, De Garmo Jones of the Secretary
 of Michigan and Nathan Jenkins of the state of
 Ohio, are Citizens of the United States,

the owners of the Ship or Vessel, called the *Marie Antoinette*
 of *Dunkirk* whereof ~~the~~ *Simon Fox*
 is at present Master; and, as he hath affirmed
 is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built
 at Sandusky in the state of Ohio in the year One thousand
 Eight hundred and twenty six as appears by the Certificate
 of Enrolment dated at the port of Buffalo Creek the first
 day of April 1828. which is this day surrounded
 by reason of a change of owners and the said Enrolment

having certified that
 the said Ship or Vessel has *One* Deck and *two* Masts and that
 her length is *Seventy-two* feet and *six* inches
 her breadth *Twenty* feet and *seven* inches
 her depth *Six* feet and *six* inches
 and that she measures *Eighty six*
 tons and *Eighty five* ninety-fifths parts of a ton;
 that she is a *Schooner* has *no* gallery
 and *Scow* head.

And that said *Isaac S. Smith* having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having
 been given according to the said Act, the said *Schooner* has been duly
Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo Creek.**
