



ENROLMENT In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same;" Samuel Bosworth of Buffalo in the state of New York and John Vail of Chautauque County, same State

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that the said Bosworth is a

Citizen of the United States,

the owner of the Ship or Vessel, called the *Mollan* of Buffalo whereof the said John Vail is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in the state of Ohio in the year One thousand eight hundred and twenty five as appears by the Certificate of Record dated at the Port of Buffalo Creek the Eleventh day of September 1829 and Number Two which is this day seen and the said Certificate of Record

having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is Fifty four feet and five inches her breadth Seventeen feet and three inches her depth five feet and six inches and that she measures Thirty three tons and Eighty one ninety-fifths parts of a ton; that she is a Schooner has no gallery and no head.

And that said Samuel Bosworth having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner has been duly

Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
