ENROLMENT In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," *Meriam Pratt* Merchant of Buffalo in the State of New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with *Justin Rice* of Detroit in the Territory of Michigan *William Johnson* of Sandusky City in the State of Ohio and *Richard Sears* of Buffalo in the County of Erie and State of New York are

Citizens of the United States,

the owners of the Ship or Vessel, called the *Commerce* of Buffalo whereof the said *John Dunham* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sandusky in the State of Ohio in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five as appears by the Certificate of Enrolment dated at the Port of Detroit the eighth day of June 1829. & N^o. 5. which has this day been surrendered by reason of a change of owner

And the said Certificate of Enrolment having certified that

the said Ship or Vessel has *One* Deck and *Two* Masts and that her length is *Seventy two* feet her breadth *Twenty feet and six inches* her depth *Six feet and ten inches* and that she measures *Eighty Eight*

tens and *no* ninety-fifths parts of a ton;

that she is a *Schooner* has *No* gallery and *Scroll* head.

And that said *Meriam Pratt* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Schooner* has been duly

Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo Creek.**
