ENROLMENT In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same." *Sheldon Thompson* forwarding Merchant of Buffalo Cr. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he together with *John S. Kimbely*, *Charles Townsend*, *George Coit* Estates of *Noble H. Merrin*, *Charles M. Siddings* and *Medburn M. Standard* are

Citizens of the United States,

sole owners of the Ship or Vessel, called the *Eclipse* of *New Buffalo* whereof *John Shook* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Vermillion* in the County of *Merou* in the State of *Ohio* in the year *1823* as appears by her Enrolment dated at the Port of *Buffalo Creek* the *15th* day of *May* in the year *1829* and numbered four *H.* which has this day been surrendered by reason of her hailing from a different port

And the said Enrolment

having certified that

the said Ship or Vessel has *one* Deck and *two* Masts and that her length is *Sixty three* feet her breadth *Eighteen* feet *Six* inches her depth *four* feet *nine* inches and that she measures *fifty Eight* tons and *two* ninety-fifths parts of a ton; that she is a *Schooner* has *No* Gallies and *Scull* head.

And that said *Sheldon Thompson* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said *Schooner* has been duly

Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo Creek.**
