are owners of the Ship or Vessel, called the Beaver of Buffalo & — whereof the said William Dornes is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Erie in the State of Pennsylvania in the year 1820 and raised up as in the year 1827 as appears by his certificate of enrolment dated at the port of Buffalo Creek the 26th day of May 1829 and numbered 7, which is now surrendered by reason of a change of owners

And the said Certificate of Enrolment having certified that

the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is Fifty six feet her breadth twenty feet and six inches her depth five feet and three inches and that she measures forty four Tons;

and that she is a Schooner ^{ninety fifth parts of a ton;} has 110 gallon and 1700 head.

And that said William Dornes having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner has been duly

Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, this fourteenth Day of June in the Year one thousand eight hundred and Thirty.
