 of *Buffalo*, whereof the said *Levi Allen*
 is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn*
 is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built
 at *Sainsville* in the State of *Ohio* in the year
 1826 appears by a Certificate of Enrolment
 dated at the port of *Buffalo Creek* the
 14th day of *July* 1829 and numbered 9,
 which is this day *subscribed* at this office
 And the said Enrolment

having certified that
 the said Ship or Vessel has *one* Deck and *two* Masts and that
 her length is *Sixty Eight* feet
 her breadth *Twenty one* feet and *five* inches
 her depth *Seven* feet and *seven* inches
 and that she measures *Thirty Three*
 tons and *Nineteen* ninety-fifths parts of a ton;
 that she is a *Schooner* has *no* Gallery
 and *no* head.

And that said *Richard Sears* having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having
 been given according to the said Act, the said *Schooner* has been duly
Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo Creek.**

 of *July* in the Year one thousand
 eight hundred and *Thirty*.
