



ENROLMENT In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries, and for Regulating the same," Sylvanus Shuttleff, Mayor of Erie County & State of New York

having taken or subscribed the oath required by the said Act, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States,

sole owner of the Ship or Vessel, called the *Repulse* of *Cattaraugus* whereof the said *Amoson Mayhew* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built somewhere on Lake Champlain in the year 1827 and used as a scow, was brought here this Spring on the Erie Canal to a mast built upon her by the present owner

And *Jay Handy* Jr

having certified that

the said Ship or Vessel has one half Deck and one Mast and that her length is Sixty Eight feet 4 inches her breadth Twelve feet six inches her depth 3 feet 8 inches and that she measures Thirty

tons and 47 $\frac{1}{95}$ ninety-fifths parts of a ton;

that she is a Sloop Scow has no glory flat bottom, no keel and no head.

And that said *Sylvanus Shuttleff* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Scow *Repulse* has been duly

Enrolled at the Port of **Buffaloe Creek.**
