 the **United States of America**, entitled "An Act for Enrol-
 ling and Licensing Ships and Vessels to be employed in the Coasting Trade and Fisheries,
 and for Regulating the same," *Henry Root of Buffalo*

having taken or subscribed the *oath* required by the said Act, and having
 sworn that he together with *Edward Root*

an Citizen s of the United States,

do owner s of the Ship or Vessel, called the *Audron*
 of *Buffalo* whereof the said *A. K. Randall*
 is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn
 is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built
 in the state of New York in 1826, as appears by
 a Certificate of Enrolment dated at the port
 of Buffalo Creek May 15, 1829. and numbered
 Five (5) which is now surrounded by reason
 of a change of owner

And the said Enrolment
 having certified that
 the said Ship or Vessel has *one* Deck and *two* Masts and that
 her length is *26* feet
 her breadth *15* " *2* inches
 her depth *5 1/2* "
 and that she measures *forty seven*
 tons and *34* *ninety-fifths* parts of a ton;
 that she is a *Schooner* has *no* gallery
 and *Beitell* head.

And that said *Henry Root* having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having
 been given according to the said Act, the said *Schooner* has been duly
Enrolled at the **Port of Buffalo Creek.**
