having taken or subscribed the affirmation required by the said Act, and having affirmed that he together with A. P. Bromberg of Detroit are

Citizens of the United States,

are owners of the Ship or Vessel, called the *President* of Buffalo whereof the said *Samuel Sanderson* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States; and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River in the state of Ohio in the year 1831 appears by the affirmation of Isaac S. Smith

And *Joy Handy* is

Deputy Collector Buffalo Creek having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is 65 1/2 feet her breadth 19 1/2 do her depth 6 1/2 do and that she measures 72 tons and 4 ninety-fifths parts of a ton; that she is a Schooner and has no gallery and a Rigg head.

And that said *Isaac S. Smith* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given according to the said Act, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
