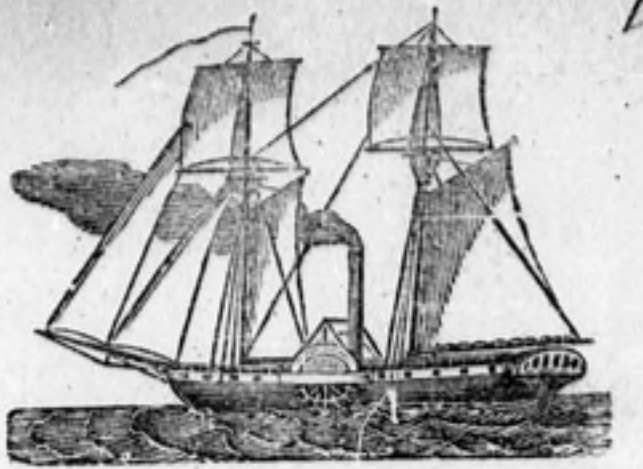

# Enrolment.

**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *John Wilson of the State of Pennsylvania Master and managing owner*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he *together with George B. Webster of Buffalo, Indiana, W. Ransom of Sankusky Ind. M. Kelly an Asha-ell W. Nabmoth of Cleveland State of Ohio are*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Ship* or Vessel called the *Nucleus of Buffalo* whereof the *Said John S. Wilson* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River* in the year 1827 as appears by *Certificate of Enrolment this day surrendered*

And the *Said certificate of enrolment* having certified that the said *Ship* or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her length is *Sixty five feet* her breadth *Twenty four feet* her depth *Seven feet four inches* and that she measures *Ninty three* tuns *Sixty eight ninety-fifths*; that she is a *Schooner* has *no*

*Gallery* and *Pillet* head. And the said *John S. Wilson* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.*

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *7th* day of *August* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *one*
