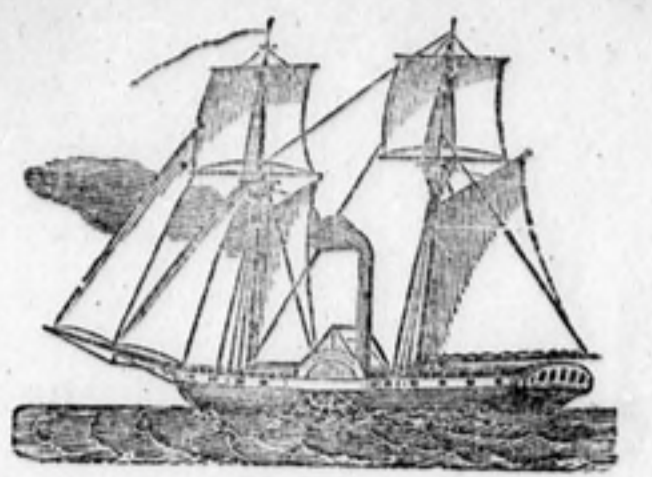


Enrolment.

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *George B. Webster of Buffalo in the State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *Aaron Root and Kelly & Walworth of the State of Ohio* are

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Young America* of Buffalo whereof *Aaron Root* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River Ohio* in the year 1825 as appears by her Enrolment dated *Buffalo May 1st 1830* and now *surrendered change of owners*

And the said Enrolment *George B. Webster and Billett* having certified that the said Sch^r or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her length is *Sixty seven feet and six inches* her breadth *Nineteen feet six inches* her depth *Five feet and ten inches* and that she measures *Sixty five* tuns & *37* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no gallery* and *Billett* head.

And the said *George B. Webster* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *George B. Webster* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *Sixteenth* day of *July* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *one*
