IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Miram Pratt of Buffalo Erie County N.Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *Wm D. P. Taylor of the same place and Morris Tyler George Moore Wetton M. Hill Cyrus Burchard & Do. Keage of Sandusky Ohio & Una Ida Sanford of Huron. Ohio* are

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Ship or Vessel called the *Ohio of Buffalo* whereof *Morris Tyler* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn*

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Lower Sandusky Ohio* in the year 1830 as appears by *her Enrolment* dated at the Port of *Portland July 8th 1830 and No. 7* (shown) which is this day *surrendered*

And the said *Enrolment* having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her length is *one hundred and six feet & nine inches* her breadth *nineteen feet and seven inches* her depth *Eight feet and one half inch* and that she measures *one hundred & fifty seven tons & forty three ninety-fifths*; that she is a *Steam Boat* has *no Gallery* and *Scroll* head.

And the said *Miram Pratt* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.*
