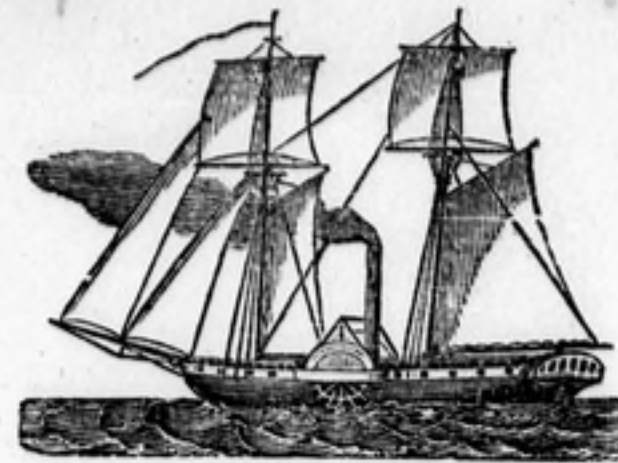




Enrolment.



IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Isaac S. Smith* of Buffalo County of Erie State of New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *Charles Burnett* of the same place are

Citizen of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Young Lion* of Buffalo whereof *Charles Burnett* is at present Master; and, as he hath Affirmed is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built ^{upon} at Buffalo New York in the year 1830 as appears by her Enrolment ^{made} at Buffalo Creek 23rd Apr 1830 and numbered two which is this day Surrendered And by the said Enrolment *Isaac S. Smith* having certified that the said Sch^r. or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is Sixty three feet her breadth Twenty feet her depth Seven feet & nine inches and that she measures Eighty three tuns & 20 ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no Gallery and a Scull head. And the said *Isaac S. Smith* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this 15th day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty one
