United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he *Isaac F. Smith Waller Smith George A. French* Merchants of the State of New York & *Obadiah Jenkins* and *Walter Jenkins* of the State of Ohio and *De Garmo Sons* of the Territory of Michigan

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Ship* or Vessel called the *Main Antionette* whereof *Benjamin Sweet* is at present Master; and, as he hath *Sworn*

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sandusky Ohio* in the year *1826* as appears by a Certificate of Registry issued at *Cleveland Ohio* April 13, 1831, and No. 1, which is this day *summand*

And the said *Register* having certified that the said *Ship* or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her length is *Seventy two feet and six inches* her breadth *Twenty feet & seven inches* her depth *Six feet and eight inches* and that she measures *Eighty six* tons & *50* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no gallery* and *Scroll* head.

And the said *J. B. Macy* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
