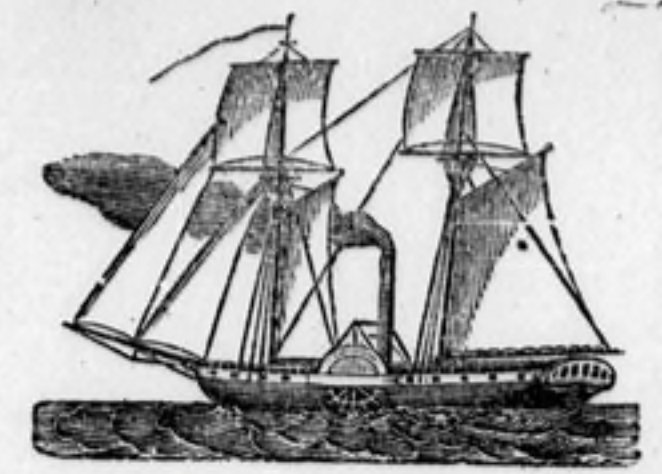

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831.

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the ~~Charles~~ *Portland* Post Boy whereof John Haggerty is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Portland Harbor in the year 1832 as appears by the oath of the Master

And Joy Hawley Esq. Collector having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has ~~one~~ *two* decks and ~~two~~ *two* masts and that her length is 59 ft. 3 inches her breadth 18 ft. her depth 6 ft. and 1 inch and that she measures Fifty five tons & 14 ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no gallery
