IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *W. J. Pease*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *J. A. Barker Army Post J. L. Hinckley Shelton Thompson Ebenezer Johnson H. A. Signe Bela D. Cox Chas. Townsend Geo. Govt of the state of N. York and Geo. T. Allaire of New Jersey*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the *Superior of Buffalo* whereof *W. J. Pease* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo N.Y.* in the year 18*32* as appears by the Enrolment of *9th June 1831 No. 2. Now amended Change of owner* And the said Certificate of Enrolment having certified that the said Boat or Vessel has *One deck and Two masts* and that her length is *126 ft. 6 in* her breadth *28 - 8 -* her depth *10 - 6 -* and that she measures *346* tuns *38* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steam Boat* and has *no Gallies* and *Billie* head.

And the said *W. J. Pease* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *W. J. Pease* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
