IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. Augustin Eaton of Buffalo Erie Co. N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with Sheldon Chapin & James P. Forest

Citizen of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Benjamin Turk whereof John Caggerty is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Erie Pennsylvania in the year 1828 ~~by~~ by the United States and employed as a Revenue Cutter and Voy. Candy having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has two masts and one deck and that her length is fifty seven feet her breadth fifteen feet her depth five feet and that she measures thirty seven tons and 85 ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no Gallery and no head. And the said Augustin Eaton having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Ship has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
