IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Melden Thompson* of Erie County New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *Charles Townsend George Coit John S. Winterly Bela Lee of Buffalo N.Y. Griffith P. Griffith John M. Griffith of Troy William Griffith David Griffith of Rochester James Platt of Utica Wymon C. Baldwin Charles M. Geddings of Cleveland Ohio Charles M. Reed of Erie Pa. De Garne Jones of Genesee N.Y.* Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Steamboat or Vessel called the *New York of Buffalo* whereof *George Miles Jr.* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black Rock* in the year 1833 as appears by a certificate from *Joy Candy Jr. Dep. Collector*. And the said *Joy Candy Jr.* having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has one deck and no masts and that her length is one hundred forty one feet one inch her breadth twenty four feet her depth ten feet two inches and that she measures three hundred twenty five tons thirty two ninety-fifths; that she is *Steamboat* has no *Galley*

And the said *Melden Thompson* and *George Miles Jr.* head. having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Ship* has been duly Enroled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this 10<sup>th</sup> day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty three
