IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *A. Eaton*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he *together with Samuel Miller of Indiana*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Schoon* or Vessel called the *Post Boy* whereof *J. Whitaker* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Portland Harbor* in the year 1832 as appears by *his Enrolment*

And *the said Enrolment* having certified that the said *sch.* or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *59 ft 3 inches* her breadth *18 feet* her depth *6 feet 1 inch* and that she measures *56* tuns *14* ninety-fifths; that she is a *schoon* has *no gallery*

and no head. And the said *A. Eaton* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *has been duly Enroled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.*
