IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Jacob A. Barker*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *Henry Root John Kimberly Sheldon Thompson Penezer Johnson Henry H. Sizer Bela C. Coe Chas. Townsend George Coit Wm. Pease & Felix Peltier* all of the State of N.Y. are

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Steamboat or Vessel called the *Superior* whereof *Jeri Allen* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo N.Y.* in the year *1822* as appears by her enrolment dated at *Buffalo June 28th 1830* & *N^o eight* & now *under a change of owner*

And said Certificate of enrolment having certified that the said Steamboat or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her length is *126 feet 6 inches*

her breadth *28* in *8* in

her depth *10* in *6* in

and that she measures *346* tuns *38* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steamboat* has *no* Gallery and *Figure* head.

And the said *Jacob A. Barker* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *S. B.* has been duly Enroled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
