IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Walter Joy of Buffalo in the State of New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *George D Webster Ebenezer D Norton Henry Norton & Thomas Carlisle of Buffalo New York Aaron Root & John Shelton of Black River Ohio John S Whiting Henry A Arvey of Lehigh N.Y.*

Citizen of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Florida of Buffalo* whereof *Aaron Root* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River Ohio* in the year 1834 as appears by the enrolment dated at the Port of Buffalo May 23^d 1834 numbered 10 Ben. And *Elisha Tibbety dep. Col.* having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is Eighty four feet nine inches her breadth Twenty three feet five inches her depth Nine feet one inch and that she measures one hundred fifty seven tons sixty four ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no Galleries and head. And the said *Walter Joy* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
