Citizen of the United States, sole owners of the Brig or Vessel called the *Indiana* whereof *Charles Burnett* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River Ohio* in the year 1834, as appears by a certificate of the Master *Comptroller George Washington Jones*

And the said *G. W. Jones* having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her length is *Ninety eight feet nine inches* 98. 9 her breadth *Twenty five feet two inches* 25. 2 her depth *Nine feet eight inches* 9. 8

and that she measures *two hundred & fourteen tun twenty four ninety-fifths*; that she is a *Brig* has *no Galleries* and a *figure* head.

And the said *W. A. Porter Taylor* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
