No. 7 of 1834

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Richard Sears of Buffalo N.Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *Sarah Burchard Esq. of Buffalo and Rodolphus Dickson of Lower Sandusky Ohio and Whiting & Tracy of Detroit N. Territory*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Nyandot* whereof

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Lower Sandusky Ohio* in the year 1833 as appears by her enrolment dated at the port of *Portland* the 3^d day of *September* 1833 and now

surrounded by reason of a change of owners And the said enrolment was having certified that the said Sch. or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her length is *Seventy feet ten inches* 77.10 her breadth *twenty two feet* 22.00 her depth *six feet seven inches* 6.07 and that she measures *ninety eight* tuns *fifty one* ninety-fifths; that she is *a Schooner* has *no Gallies* and *no* head.

And the said Schooner having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sch. has been duly Enroled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
