**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *John Kimbely* of Buffalo Creek N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *Sheldon Thompson Charles Townsend George Coit & Benjamin F. Norton* of the same place *Charles K. Geddings & Norman C. Baldwin* of Cleveland Ohio are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Constitution* whereof *Abiram Higgins* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sandusky Ohio* in the year 1835 as appears by her enrolment dated at Buffalo April 20<sup>th</sup> 1833 and now surrendered by reason of a change of owners And the said enrolment having certified that the said Ship or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her length is *Seventy one feet* her breadth *Twenty feet and six inches* her depth *Seven feet and six inches* and that she measures *nearly one* tons *seventy seven ninety-fifths*; that she is a Schooner has *no* Gallies and *no* head. And the said *John Kimbely* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
