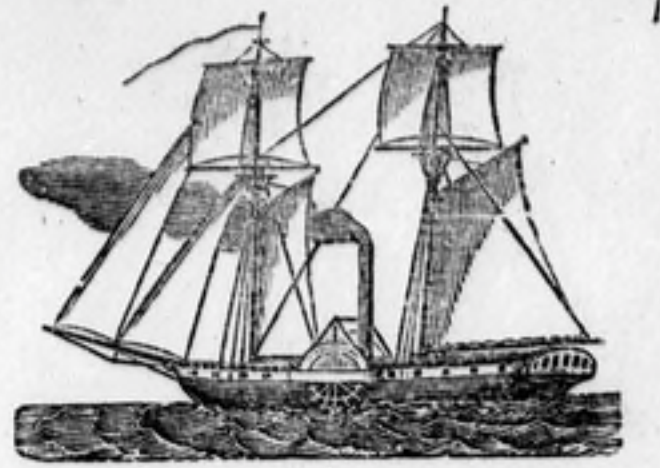

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with Daniel Brown, James Hoas and Abraham Ashton of Michigan City in the State of Indiana are

Citizen of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Post Boy of Buffalo whereof Morgan Edgecomb is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Portland Harbor N.Y. in the year 1832 as appears by her enrolment dated at Buffalo Sept 10th 1833 (numbered 20) now surrendered by reason of a change of owners. And the said enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is fifty nine feet three inches her breadth Eighteen feet her depth six feet and one inch and that she measures fifty six tons fourteen ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no Gallies and no head. And the said Augustus Eaton having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schⁿ has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
