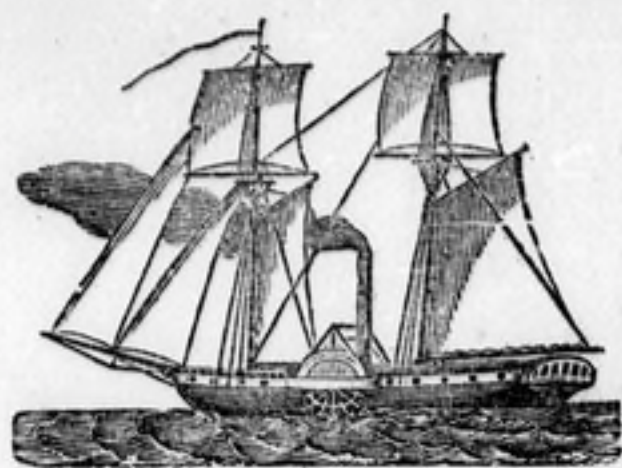

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Augustus Todd*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *Darius Smith and Luther Hagedorn* are

Citizen, of the United States, sole owner, of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Benjamin Bush* of Buffalo whereof *Augustus Todd* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cree Pennsylvania* in the year 1828 as appears by her Enrolment Date *Buffalo Apr. 26 1833* and Number *five* now surrendered by *Reason of a change of owner* and he hath sworn that he is the said Enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *two* Masts and *one* Deck and that her length is *fifty seven* feet her breadth *fifteen* feet her depth *five* feet and that she measures *thirty seven* tons *eighty five* ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has *no* galleys

and *scroll* head. And the said *Augustus Todd* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enroled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *23rd* day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *five*
