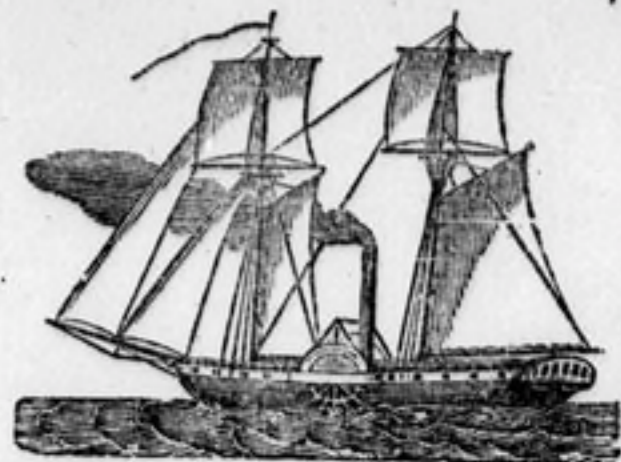

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831.

J. S. Barton

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he *together with Alfred Williams* and *both of Cleveland Ohio* are

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *John Grant* of Buffalo whereof *John Nelson* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Brighton N.Y.* in the year 1833 as appears by *his enrolment dated at Buffalo Oct 23^d 1834 & No 28* the day of *his* *change of owners*

And *the said enrolment* having certified that the said *Sch* or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *twenty four feet & six inches* *7 1/2* 6 her breadth *twenty feet & three inches* *20* 03 her depth *six feet & eleven inches* *6* 11 and that she measures *Ninety two* tuns & *three* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no* *Gallery* and *Billit* head.

And the said *James S. Barton* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sch* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *thirtieth* day of *July* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *five*
