



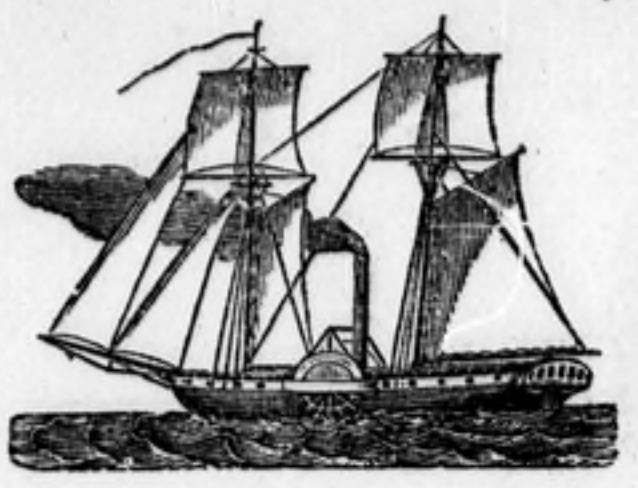

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Joseph White of White Haven Erie Co. N.Y. merchant*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he is a

*Surrendered & new enrolment issued
Sept 15. 1836. Change of owners.*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Owanungah of White Haven* whereof *Chas. S. Deverney* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *White Haven N.Y.* in the year 1835 as appears by the certificate of *B. D. Delaney* master builder

And *E. S. Deverney* having certified that the said sch or Vessel has on deck and then masts and that her length is *Eighty two feet and five inches* her breadth *twenty feet and two inches* her depth *eight feet and two inches* and that she measures *One hundred twenty nine tons and 76 ninety-fifths*; that she is a Schooner has *no gallery* and *Pillitt* head.

And the said *Joseph White* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *sch.* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *30th* day of *July* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *five*
