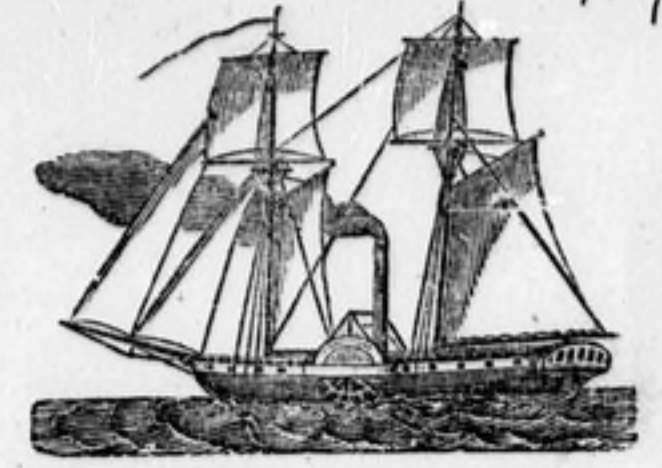

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Richard Sears*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he *together with* *R Sears*

Citizen of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Dayton of Buffalo* whereof *John Cole* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Main Island N.Y.* in the year 1835 as appears by the oath of the *managing owner*

And *Joy Handy* *deft* *Cole* having certified that the said *Sch* or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *sixty nine feet two inches* *69.02* her breadth *nineteen feet nine inches* *19.09* her depth *seven feet one inch* *7.01* and that she measures *eighty four* *tuns* *forty one* *ninety-fifths*; that she is a *Schooner* has *no* *Galley*

and *Billet* head. And the said *Richard Sears* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sch* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *fourteenth* day of *September* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *five*
