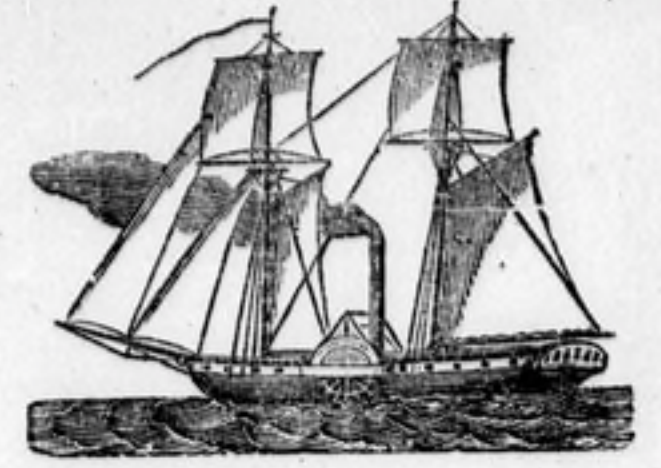

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Henry Norton of Buffalo N.Y*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with *Emory F Norton Thomas Carleton of Buffalo N.Y. and R & G Lockwood of Huron, Catho*

*Surrounded at this Port August 2^o 1838
having changed owners and new Papers
granted.*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Eclipse of Buffalo* whereof *John Benson* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Wilmington Ohio* in the year 1833 as appears by her enrolment dated at the port of *Portland Ohio Sept 11th 1833* now surrounded at this office. And the said Certificate of enrolment having certified that the said *Sch* or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her length is *fifty six feet* her breadth *sixteen feet four inches* her depth *six feet six inches* and that she measures *forty eight* tuns *sixty one* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no Gallies* and *no* head. And the said *Henry Norton* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sch* has been duly Enroled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *24th* day of *September* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *five*
