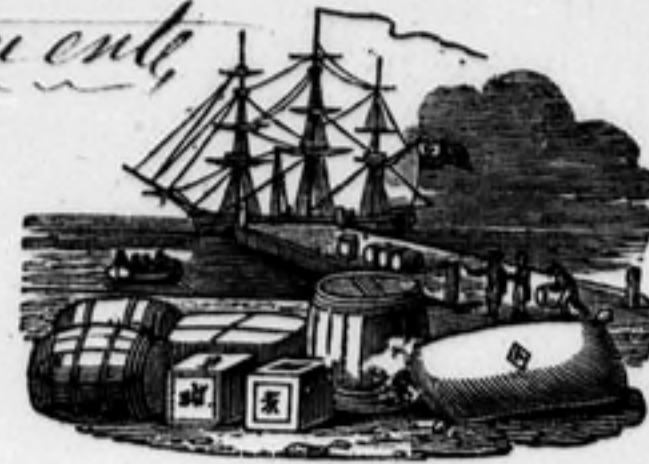
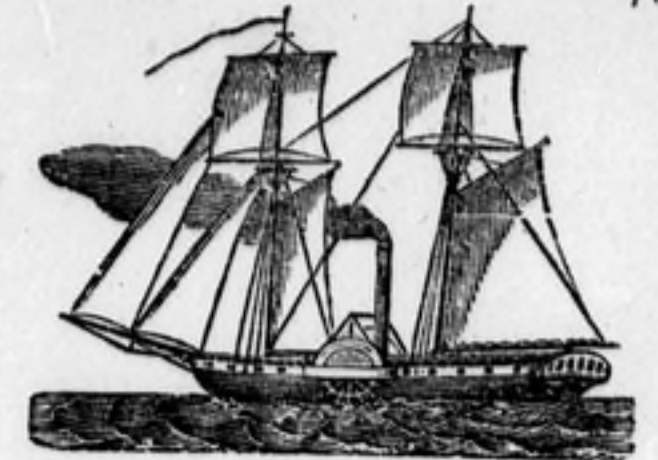

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831.

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Steam Boat* or Vessel called the *Gov. Murray* whereof *Samuel Chase* is at present Master; and, as he hath Sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black Rock* in the year 1833 as appears by *the oath of the managing owner.*

And having certified that the said *Steam Boat* or Vessel has *an deck* and length is *one hundred and twenty five feet* her breadth *Eighteen feet and six inches* her depth *Seven feet and three inches* and that she measures *one hundred & forty outons & eighty ninety-fifths* that she is a *Steam Boat* and has *no Gallies* and *Signed* head.

And the said *William S. P. Taylor* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *9th* day of *April* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *six*.
