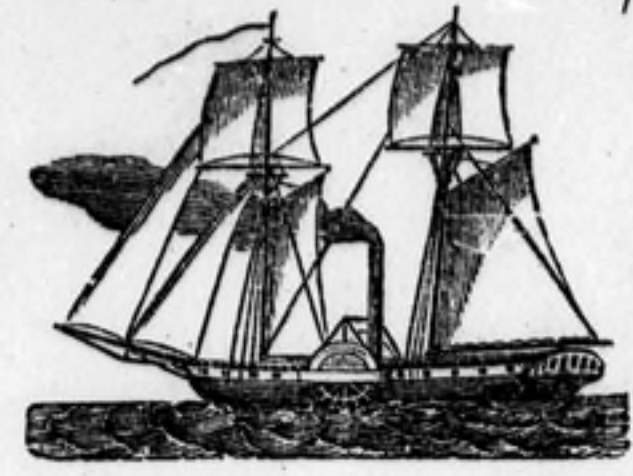

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. Isaac Smith

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with John J. O'Leary and a King Russell are the

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Young Lion* whereof *Wm. J. Moran* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo N.Y.* in the year 1830 as appears by her Enrolment dated at *Buffalo May 10 1836* and number *16 Porten* And the said enrolment having certified that the said *Sch* or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *Seventy three feet* her breadth *Twenty five feet* her depth *Seven feet six inches* and that she measures *Eighty three* tuns *20* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no gunnis* and *no roll* head.

And the said having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sch* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *10* day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *six*
