IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Wolsey W. Badcliff*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he *together with* *Mathew Brain Jr* *John Plase* *Henry Norton* *John J Williams*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Ship* or Vessel called the *Serein* whereof *Augusta Water* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River Ohio* in the year 1834 as appears by *the enrolment dated at Buffalo May 11 1836 and numbered 118 Eighteen* And *the said enrolment* having certified that the said *Ship* or Vessel has *one deck* and *one mast* and that her length is *Sixty feet and three inches* her breadth *ten feet and 1/4 inches* her depth *five feet and three 1/4 inches* and that she measures *fifty two* tuns *ninety-fifths*; that she is *a Ship* has *no gallies* and *Billitt* head.

And the said *Wolsey W. Badcliff* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Ship* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *11* day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *six*
