having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he together with William Runtton and Wm Brewster are

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *United States* whereof

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at

Panville Ohio in the year 1826 as appears by *see enrolment dated Buffalo Apr 20 1833 and No 2 now surrendered by reason of a change of Owners*

And *the said enrolment* having certified that

the said *Sch* or Vessel has *one deck and two masts* and that her

length is *sixty eight feet*

her breadth *Twenty one feet and five inches*

her depth *Seven feet and seven inches*

and that she measures *Ninety three* tons *nintend ninety-fifths* ; that she is a *Schooner* has *no gallery* and *head.*

And the said *Thomas Cooke* having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said

Sch has been duly Enroled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
