



# Enrolment.

**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Thomas Cook*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he *together with William Ruston and George Miles Jr*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Barge* or Vessel called the *Seton*, whereof *George Miles Jr*

is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Captown from the Brick in the year 1812 as appears by the certificate of Leander Woodruff dep Collector at Erie Pennsylvania*

And *Clark Kimler by dep Collector* having certified that the said *Barge* or Vessel has *the masts* and *on deck* and that her length is *thirty six feet and two inches* her breadth *thirty six feet* her depth *three feet and one inch* and that she measures *two hundred and forty four tons forty one ninety-fifths*; that she is *a Barge* has *no guns*

and *scow* head. And the said *Thomas Cook* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Barge* has been duly Enroled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *2* day of *August* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *six*
