IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Augustus H. Scoville & Madison Weeks of Buffalo N.Y. and Isaac Lockwood & W. Reed of Richmond Ohio are

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Wave of Buffalo* whereof Madison Weeks is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Richmond Ohio in the year 1836 as appears by the affidavit of Isaac Lockwood Master Carpenter

And Elisha Kimberly depy Coby having certified that the said Sch or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is eighty feet and two inches

her breadth twenty three feet three inches her depth eight feet and four inches

and that she measures one hundred thirty four tons eighty nine ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no galleries

and scroll head.

And the said Lewis O. Allen having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sch has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
