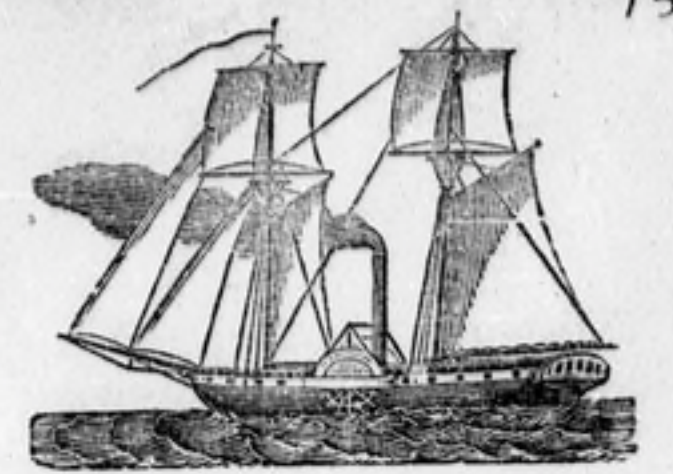

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *James C Evans*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having Sworn that he *together with Samuel F. Gelston & John Wheeler are*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schoon or Vessel called the *Charles Carroll* whereof *Orange Allen* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sandusky City Ohio* in the year 1833 as appears by *his enrolment dated at the port of Putnam Ohio May 23^d 1836, now surrendered by reason of having been required into a Schoon*

And the said enrolment of *C Evans* having certified that the said *Sch* or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *fifty three feet*

her breadth *sixteen feet four inches* her depth *six feet three and a half inches*

and that she measures *forty six* tons *twenty* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schoon* has *no galleries*

And the said *James C Evans* and *W. Scott* head.

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sch* has been duly Enroled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *ninth* day of *Sept* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *six*
