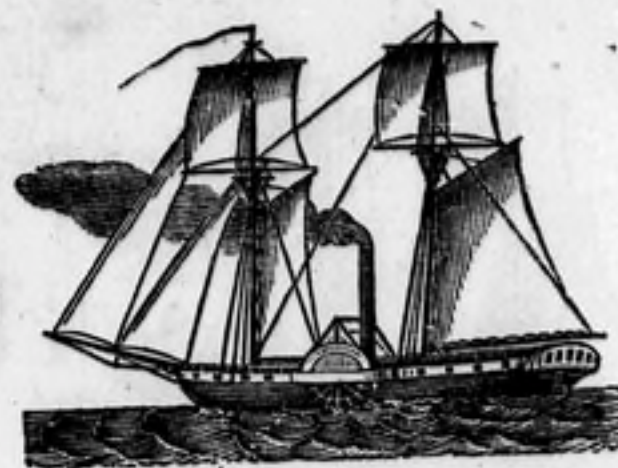

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Norath's N. V. of Buffalo N. Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Jacob A. Parker of Buffalo James M. Forsyth of Maumee and Edward Bronson and Judah Colt of Cleland Ohio* and _____

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the *Merchant of Buffalo* _____ whereof *William L. Cole* is at present Master; and, as he hath certified _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Maumee River, Ohio* in the year *1834* as appears by her enrollment dated at the port of *Buffalo May 3^d 1836, N.Y.* and now surrendered by reason of a change of owner _____ And the said enrollment _____ having certified that

the said Schooner or Vessel has *Two masts* and *one deck* and that her length is *Sixty nine feet and Four inches* her breadth *Twenty feet and Three inches* her depth *Six feet and Two inches* and that she measures *Seventy Four* _____ tuns *Forty Five* _____ ninety-fifths; that she is *Schooner rigged* _____ has *no galleries* _____ and *Scull* _____ head.

And the said *Norath's N. V.* _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
