



**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *James C. Crans of Buffalo N. Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with* *Saml. J. Sutton, John P. Crans, Mathew Kingman & David Smith Jr of Buffalo N. Y. J. P. Wattle, Esqrs Blackman, Parsons Blackman, Jacob P. Lusk & Leonard P. Hutchinson of Newark N. Y. J. F. Hyman, H. Hyman, & David Hyman of Rochester N. Y. James C. Howard of Troy N. Y. and*

*Alfred Pridge of New York City* Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Henry Ship* of *Buffalo* whereof *David Clark* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn, is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black Rock N. Y.*

in the year 1835, as appears by her enrollment dated at *Buffalo* *May 9th 1836 No 14,* now surrendered having changed owners

And the said enrollment having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *Sixty Four feet and Eight inches* her breadth *Nineteen feet and Four inches* her depth *Seven feet and Four & 1/2 inches* and that she measures *Seventy nine* tuns *Sixty Four* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and has a *Figure* head.

And the said *James C. Crans* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo Creek.*

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of *Buffalo* Creek, in the said District, this *Fifth* day of *July* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty *Seven.*
