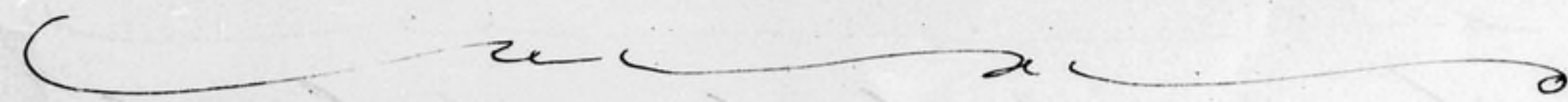


ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *John Nail of Silver Creek N. Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Oliver Lee of the same place* are



Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Savannah of Silver Creek* whereof *Gerardo C Owen* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Silver Creek N. Y.* in the year 1836 as appears by her enrollment dated at the *Port of Buffalo April 28 1836* now surrendered having changed owners And the said enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *Seventy three feet seven inches* her breadth *Twenty one feet nine inches* her depth *six feet and six inches* and that she measures *One hundred nine* tuns *forty eight* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and has a *scroll* head. And the said *John Nail* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
