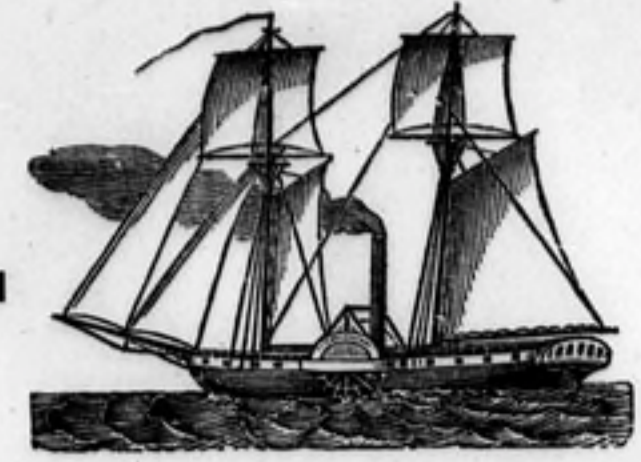


# ENROLLMENT.

## IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Wing Russell of Buffalo Erie County N. Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *Together with Noah P. Sprague, Samuel W. Hawes of Buffalo Erie County New York and Henry W. Jenkins of Huron in the State of Ohio are*

*Summended at this Port October 6. 1838. having complied with act of congress passed July 7. 1838 and now Papers granted. A. J. Robbins Buffalo*

Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Louisa Jenkins of Buffalo* whereof *Reuben Rock* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Milan Huron County Ohio* in the year 1829 as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of *Buffalo N. Y. May 2<sup>d</sup> 1837* & *Ambrudo*, and now summended by reason of a change of owner And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Sixty three feet and no inches* her breadth *Nineteen feet and two inches* her depth *Seven feet and one inch* and that she measures *Seventy Three* tuns *Fifty Seven* ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has *no galleries* and head. And the said *Wing Russell* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *Twenty fifth* day of *April* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-*Eight*
