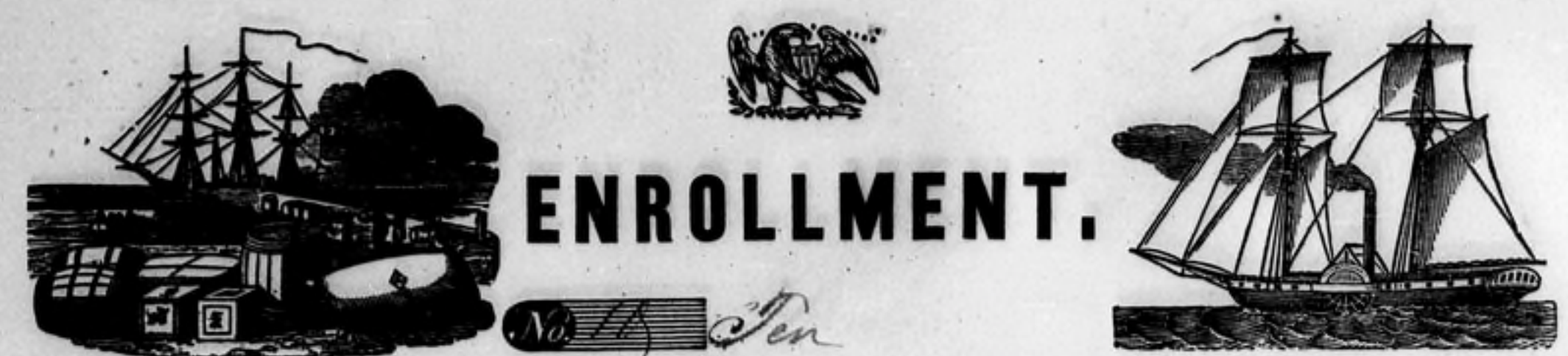




ENROLLMENT.



ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. Rufus C. Palmer of Buffalo County of Erie and State of New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with George W. Mott, Giles N. Coats, Charles Sager of Buffalo, Robert Nantz of Albany, Quaker, Silmore, Augustus Jones, George M. Jones, Prof. P. Jones, Barna, Maher, Calvin, Leonard, T. Town, Joel M. M'Quinn of Charleston Ohio, John Fleckarty of Huron Ohio and William Jay of the City of New York

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the Constitution of Buffalo whereof Charles Sager is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Charleston Ohio in the year 1834 as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo the 15th day of July 1837, and now surrendered by reason of a change of owner, and numbered thirty nine

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Steam Boat or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is One Hundred and fifty feet and six inches her breadth Twenty Eight feet and six inches her depth Twelve feet and one inch and that she measures Two hundred & Eighty three tuns Sixty ninety-fifths; that she is a Steam Boat has no galleries and has a figure head.

And the said Rufus C. Palmer having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this Twenty seventh day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-Eight
