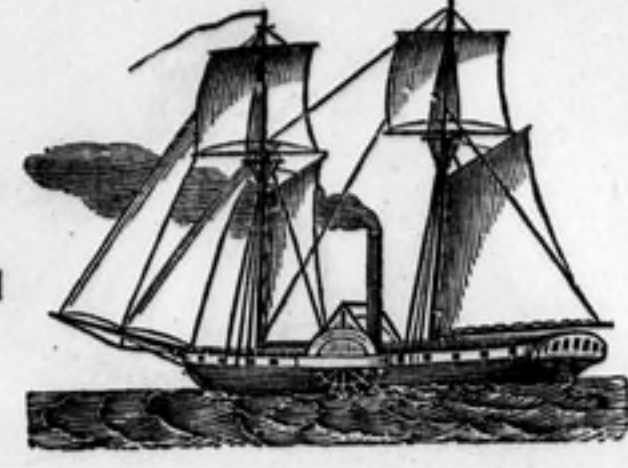
IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831.

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Conneaut in the State of Ohio in the year 1838 as appears by the Oath of G. M. Jones of Ohio Ship Carpenter and builder of the Steam Boat Wisconsin of Buffalo N. Y.
And the said G. M. Jones having certified that the said Steamboat or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is One Hundred and Fifty seven feet her breadth Twenty Nine feet and no inches her depth Three feet and Six inches and that she measures Four Hundred & Ninety tuns Six ninety-fifths; that she is a Steam Boat has no galleries and a Stern head.
And the said James C. Evans of Buffalo New York having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this Twentieth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty. Eight.
