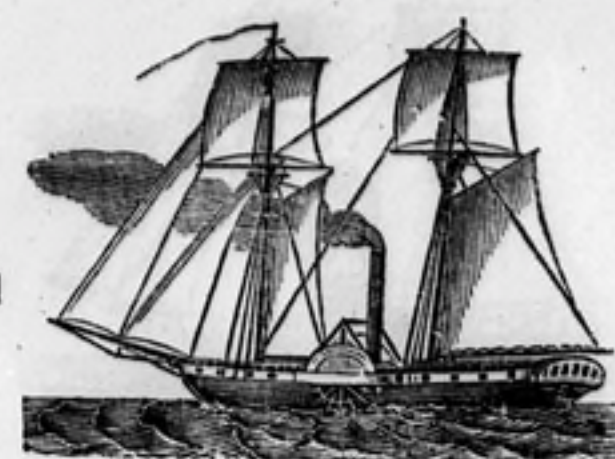

# ENROLLMENT.

No. 18 Eighteen



**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the  
 United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c.  
 passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on  
 the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other pur-  
 poses,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *John Pease of Buffalo Erie County N. Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *Together*  
*with John L. Kimberly, Sheldon Thompson, Chas Townsend, George Cobb*  
*and C. F. Weston of Buffalo N. Y. Needham, M. Standart David Griffith*  
*of Cleveland in the state of Ohio*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the  
*Constitution of Buffalo* \_\_\_\_\_ whereof *John P. Teal*  
 is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_  
 is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sandusky*  
*Ohio* in the year 1826, as appears by *his Enrollment dated at the Port*  
*of Buffalo April 28. 1826 and now surrounded by a change of owners*  
 And *the said Enrollment* \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that  
 the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* \_\_\_\_\_ and *Two Masts* \_\_\_\_\_ and that her  
 length is *Seventy one Feet and six inches* \_\_\_\_\_  
 her breadth *Twenty Feet and six inches* \_\_\_\_\_  
 her depth *Seven Feet and six inches* \_\_\_\_\_  
 and that she measures *Sixty one* \_\_\_\_\_ tuns *Seventy seven* \_\_\_\_\_ ninety-fifths;  
 that she is a Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has *no galleries* \_\_\_\_\_  
 \_\_\_\_\_ and a *Stull* \_\_\_\_\_ head.  
 And the said *John Pease of Buffalo Erie County New York* \_\_\_\_\_ having  
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been  
 given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly  
 Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
