Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Pirate of Dunkirk* whereof Isaac Morris is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Dunkirk New York in the year 1806 as appears by a Certificate of Earnest Mullett Deputy Collector and Inspector dated June 21st 1836 And the said Earnest Mullett having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Sixty four feet her breadth Twelve feet and eight inches and that she measures Thirty Seven tuns Fifty Five ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no galleries and no head. And the said Isaac Morris having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
