Walter Joy of Buffalo Erie County New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with George B. Webster of Buffalo N.Y., Nathan Whiston of Cleveland Ohio and Aaron Root of Charleston Ohio are

Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the Brig or Vessel called the North Carolina whereof William McDevitte

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sheffield Ohio in the year 1838 as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of Cleveland the 30th of October 1837 now surrendered having changed owners.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Seventy three Feet and three inches her breadth Twenty Five Feet and nine inches her depth Seven Feet and Two inches and that she measures Ninety Five tuns Fifteen ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig has no galleries and a Figure head.

And the said Walter Joy having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
