



IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Nathaniel P. Hopkins, of Lunkin,*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *Together with Walter Smith, of Lunkin, Chataugue County, New York,*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *William S. Buckner of Lunkin* whereof *Jacob Amos* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Swing New York* in the year 1837 as appears by *his* Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo *the 29th May 1837* now surrendered having *changed owners*

And *the* said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy Four Feet and Two inches* her breadth *Twenty one Feet one & one fourth inches* her depth *Seven Feet and nine inches* and that she measures *One hundred & six* tons *Thirty three* ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has *no* galleries and head.

And the said *Nathaniel P. Hopkins* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
