Blackman, Hanson Blackman, Jacob P. Smith & Leonard P. Hutchinson of Newark N.Y. J. P. Wymann, William Wymann, David Wymann, A. B. Kestler & Thos. Pease of Rochester, James C. Woodwards of Troy, Alfred Knicker, Stephen Ward, Erastus S. Prosser, & Edwin W. Bennett of New York City, Oliver Tomlinson, Robt. Schoys, Scander M. Hubby & Edwards Winice of Albany, Ben. Root, Stephen L. Pettis, and Truff & Parks of Cleveland Ohio Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the

*Henry Root of Buffalo* whereof *E. Biddle* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black Rock New York* in the year 1835 as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo, July 5<sup>th</sup> 1857 now *summersed* having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Sixty Four Feet and eight inches* her breadth *Nineteen Feet and Seven inches* her depth *Seven Feet four and a half inches* and that she measures *Seventy Nine* tuns *Sixty Four* ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has *no galleries* and has a *Square* head.

And the said *James C Evans* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
