



ENROLLMENT.

No. *41* *Port of Buffalo*

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Panatus Perry of Buffalo N.Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *is a*

Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Telegraph of Buffalo* whereof *Panatus Perry* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ashtabula Ohio* in the year 1829 as appears by *his Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo the 13th of May 1837*

And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Fifty Feet and six inches* her breadth *Eighteen Feet* her depth *Five Feet and one inch* and that she measures *Fifty three* tuns *Seventy eight* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and has *no head* head.

And the said *Panatus Perry* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
