**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *William B. Stone of Dayton Ohio* by his lawful Attorney *Richard P. Sears of Buffalo N. Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Wabash of Buffalo N. Y.* whereof *Braddock Black* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sand Island New York* in the year 1838 as appears by her Enrolment dated at the Port of Buffalo May 10. 1837 now surrendered having changed owner

And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy Seven feet and six inches* — 77.06 her breadth *Nineteen feet and nine inches* — 19.09 her depth *Seven feet and six inches* — 7.06 and that she measures *One Hundred & Two tons Forty Two* ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no galleries
